



1st ANNUAL YMCA OF READING & BERKS COUNTY CORN HOLE TOURNAMENT

GENERAL RULES

1. All teams will designate a TEAM CAPTAIN, who will be responsible for all team communication with our Y staff. They are to ensure that their team is reporting to the correct boards during game play.
2. The team captain will wear a given designation (armband) at all times so that it is easy for the Y staff to identify them.
3. There will be a time limit to report to the proper boards during game play. You will be given a first call and a second call. If you have not reported to your board within 5 minutes after the 2nd call, you will be disqualified from the tournament.

GAME RULES

1. Two players of each team shall play at any one time. Partners shall stand at opposite corn hole boxes on the same side, from the perspective of a third person, and face each other, so there is no advantage given to one team.
2. Each corn hole team will have 4 bags of one color.
3. All 8 corn hole bags begin at one end.
4. A coin flip shall determine which corn hole team has honors in Round 1.
5. One of the partners on the team who has honors shall begin play by throwing a corn hole bag at the opposite corn hole box.
6. A corn hole player may throw from anywhere behind the front of the corn hole box from which they are throwing.
7. Game continues by alternating throws between the two opponent players until all 8 corn hole bags have been thrown.
8. If a corn hole bag hits the ground then bounces up onto the board, that bag shall be taken off the playing surface.
9. The corn hole game continues until one team reaches 21 or more points. ** The very first round will only go to 15 points.**

SCORING

1. The score shall be taken after all corn hole bags have been thrown for a round.
2. Points shall be given as follows:
 - a. 3 points for a corn hole bag that goes through the hole.
 - b. 1 point for a corn hole bag that is on the playing surface.
 - c. 1 point for a corn hole bag that is hanging into the hole.
 - d. 1 point for a corn hole bag that is hanging off the edge, but not touching the ground.
 - e. 0 points for a corn hole bag that is on the playing surface, but also touching the ground.
3. The corn hole team with the highest round score, adds the difference of the two scores to their game score.
4. "Wash" when both team's points cancel each other's out.
